Taking Time to Abide

Abide in me, and I in you. As the branch cannot bear fruit by itself, unless it abides in the vine, neither can you, unless you abide in me. I am the vine; you are the branches. Whoever abides in me and I in him, he bears much fruit, for apart from me you can do nothing. John 15:4-5 (ESV)

This month, three of us from Faith Presbyterian will be taking part in the ECO National Gathering at Highland Park Presbyterian Church in Dallas, Texas.
