A Time for Us to Function As the Body of Christ

"For just as the body is one and has many members, and all the members of the body, though many, are one body, so it is with Christ. Indeed, the body does not consist of one member but of many. If one member suffers, all suffer together with it; if one member is honored, all rejoice together with it. Now you are the body of Christ and individually members of it." First Corinthians 12, selected verses

The analogy of the church as a human body is deeply rooted in scripture. The Apostle Paul was addressing significant tension, and even conflict in the church at Corinth. Paul is seeking to remind the congregation that they belong together. Paul even uses the humorous illustration of different body parts telling other body parts they do not belong to the body. Of course, that is ridiculous, but it can happen in Christian congregations, unfortunately.

Yet the parts of this chapter of Corinthians which apply to our church most right now are "the body does not consist of one member, but of many." Why? **In less than a month, our church, Faith Presbyterian, will be hosting the Fall Gathering of the Presbytery of the Northwest!** Approximately fifty Presbyterians from all over Washington and Oregon will descend upon our church for a very busy 24 hours. The first event is a lunch on Friday, October 4th, and we wind up just before noon on Saturday, October 5th.

In order for us to host the Presbytery, we will need everyone's time and talents. We will need deacons and others to prepare and serve food. We will need volunteers to serve as greeters and ushers. We will need people to serve in our sound booth for worship, and the meetings in the sanctuary. We will make use of Ron and Jeanne Lodge's talents on the piano, guitar, and voice, as well as other musicians in our congregation.
